2010 JUNE CUP SERIES – WOMEN ON THE HELM

DATES – The Tuesdays in June comprise a memorial series for June Coon Cuthbertson, a winning Columbia Challenger racer and race chair. Cancelled races won't be replaced. In 2010, June has five Tuesdays.

ELIGIBILITY, CLASS, HANDICAP, ENTRY FEE, COURSES: Same as Tuesday Races. By competing against ladies and against the entire mixed class, lady skippers often receive two race trophies, but boats pay once regardless of skipper's gender.

RULES: Same as Tuesday races, **PLUS** the lady skipper must hold the helm on most of every leg of the course, during the start and finish, all tacks, gybes and mark roundings. **ALSO**, she shall represent the boat in any protest hearing.

ENTRY: Available Tuesdays between 4:15* and 5:30 PM. One entry suffices for the June Cup series. A current Tuesday-Races entry suffices only if a lady skipper signed it. (We need to recognize our lady skippers.) *4:00 on 1st Tues.

RACE SCORING, TROPHIES: Lady skippers will be scored consecutively by Low Point (but OCS and DNF receive points equal the number of female starters; DSQ, one more). The top three ladies in each class will get a race take-home trophy. The underlying Tuesday races for skippers of either gender will be scored separately without excluding the June Cup skippers.

JUNE CUP SERIES SCORING: Female skippers starting at least two races qualify for series scoring. Raw scores will be pruned removing nonqualifiers. Nonstarters (DNC or DNS) will receive one point more than the number of qualifiers. If no race is cancelled, one score is thrown out. The sum of remaining race scores will be compared in each class.

JUNE CUP TROPHY: Only one series take-home trophy will be awarded in each class, and those winners will be engraved on the June Cup Perpetual Trophy. If there is a tie for first in any class, the sum of scores (including male skippers) in races where both ladies started will be compared with no throwout.
