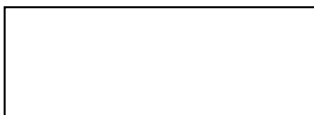

The RaceChair squeaks - Craig will hit the upcoming races, so I will summarize those already run. So far this year we have run 15 races of the 41 we will have run by Thanksgiving. On Saturdays we have run the Gail and Frank Hine Regatta (3 short races, 11 boats divided into two classes), the John Walti Regatta (3 short races, 6 boats divided into two classes) and four in our Redondo Beach Series (averaging only 6 divided into two classes). Bottom line: this low level of turnout means that although our races always make money, our committees are working almost harder than the racers are playing. I guess the squeak became a squeal. Albert Solbes is trying to help by sending me a list of KHYC racers. I will have typed them into my contacts by our next Sat race.

The Tuesday races are the same as ever. We have run seven and cancelled two (high wind, chance of shower). The turnout here was an average of 11 boats divided into 3 classes. The class I worry about is our A class (the faster boats) which averages only 2 per race. Hot Rum and Janina crews are holding this class together. Jolly good fellows.

The first meeting to schedule 2011 races is in late June 2010. At the moment I am thinking that I should vacate our Gail Hine race date in January because it always conflicts with KHYC's Commodore's Ball ("Can you hand out the trophies by 4 so we can dress etc?") and in 2011 it will be the Commodore's Cruise instead. In defense of the Jan date, notice above that the Hine Regatta was the only Sat where we had more than seven boats. I think this is because it is the first race that gets ASMBYC points in their high-point series. Also we probably want to change the 2011 name of the 2010 Waverider Y-28 race, since that destination seems to have lost our interest.

As a small club that serves liquor, we are required to follow some rules. Although this list is not exhaustive, it covers some of the most important ones. Please review them.

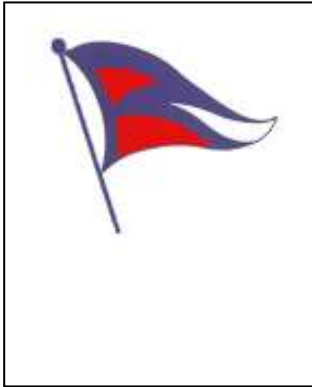
- 1) Members must have their membership card on their person to be served alcohol or admit guests.

Present your ON-LINE Confirmation and pick up your pre-printed boarding passes from agent at top of boarding ramp starting 30 minutes before departure. Parking is \$10 per day.
